HOW TO

Build a Standing Planter Box



Shelly likes to grow a vegetable garden in the summer. I love tomatoes and reap many rewards in good growing years. Until a few months ago our house had a small vacant lot next to it. Well Kirkland, like many Puget Sound neighborhoods, is exploding with growth. A two story house was constructed blocking sun to Shelly's current raised garden box. Problem!

Our back yard has always been challenging to find a good spot with enough sun for Shelly's garden. So this year I decided to build standing garden boxes that could be moved if necessary to get optimal sun exposure for those tomatoes I love.

The internet has all kinds of examples and I picked one. The one I built has a cedar wood box sitting on top of a 2' x 4' wood base. I used 1' x 6' cedar boards for the box. I also chose to use a Kreg joiner to hide the screw holes, which increased the build time significantly. I had to pre-drill every screw that was used, don't underestimate the effort this takes. However, the end result is spectacular!

GREAT GADGETS for Cycling

Power Charger - SIVA CYCLE

Pedal powered charger for your bicycle electronics. Genius!! You can now run power to your handlebars to plug in your iphone, android, GPS, lights, GoPro, or other bike computer. The charger attaches to the frame near the rear wheel. It's fairly small, weighs only 330 grams or ¾ lbs., about the weight of a banana. The charger will never pull more than 10% of effort from the rider. That means it charges about 1% per minute, which is about the same as if you are plugged into the wall. Theft Proof Light - FORTIFIED BICYCLE

If you bicycle in the city theft of your bike and accessories are always a concern. Top 3 reasons people bike without a light is; they forgot it, they lost it, or it was stolen. This light locks on the handle bars so it can't be stolen. A security screw that is not common locks the light onto your handle bars. The light is lightweight aluminum and does not rust, so it's waterproof. It has a super cool unique design that no other light has. Love it! <http://fortifiedbike.com>

Crash Sensor - ICEDOT

Riding alone and you crash and are unconscious, who's going to help? ICEDot's helmet mounted sensor will sense trouble and contact help. An impact sensor, notification system, medic alert and GPS all in one, ICEDot monitors the gravity of a fall with an accelerometer and notifies up to 10 emergency contacts of your choosing via text message. It's also able to track your location coordinates, so if you're alone, assistance can find you. A compatible wrist band has a unique ID that provides vital medical information for first responders, much like medical ID bracelets of yore. All you do is secure ICEDot to any helmet, download the free smartphone app, create your profile, and hit the road. Great protection! <https://icedot.org/site>

Don't Let SOCIAL MEDIA Ruin Your Car Accident Claim

For the amount of complaining we do about privacy in America, we are all just a little too willing to put very private details of our lives on Facebook or Twitter. However, your car accident case can be ruined with one bad post.

Above all else, you should never misrepresent your injuries during a personal injury case. You won't have anything to worry about or anything to get "caught at" if you've been truthful from the start, and that's the way it should be. People who overdramatize or exaggerate their injuries for money don't deserve it, and we choose not to work with those types of clients.

Top Secret Tip - your insurance company and their lawyers can see all of your public posts and they're probably looking the moment your accident is reported. You might think this is obvious, but you'd be shocked at how many cases in Washington are ruined because someone is claiming a life-changing injury, but their Facebook page shows that they went on a week-long ski trip last month. These things matter in a case and can cost you dearly.



If you mislead the insurance companies and their lawyers into believing you can't do certain things, and then you post videos or pictures showing you can do those things, your claim will most certainly suffer. With that in mind, here's our advice:

- **Always be straightforward and truthful about your claim.**
- **Don't put stupid content on Facebook, Twitter or anywhere on the web.**
- **If you have stupid stuff on any social media site, don't hide it, you will make matters worse.**
- **Tell your friends not to post stupid stuff about you either.**

Shelly's RECIPE CORNER

Peanut Butter
**S'MORES
BARS**

INGREDIENTS

- 14 graham crackers
- ¾ cup butter or margarine, softened
- ¼ cup peanut butter, preferably crunchy
- ½ cup semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1 can (14 oz.) sweetened condensed milk
- 3 cups marshmallows

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 375 degrees.

Process graham crackers in a food processor or crush into coarse crumbs. Add butter and peanut butter and blend. Spread mixture on bottom of 9" x 13" baking dish to form crust. Sprinkle with chocolate chips; drizzle with milk to cover chips.

Bake for 30 minutes or until top is bubbly. Cool completely. Just before serving sprinkle with marshmallows. Broil 3 to 4 inches from heat until lightly browned. Let stand a few minutes before cutting into 24 bars. Enjoy!
